Agriculture is one of Santa Rosa County's top industry sectors. Part of TEAM's mission is to promote our local industry, and to that end, we recently applied for and received a \$175,000 USDA grant that will enable a Revolving Loan Fund Committee to offer loans to local farmers desiring a transition to specialty crop production.

Pricing Guidelines for NWFL Industrial Park at I-10 have been set. The base price of the property is \$50,000 per acre and discounts are available based on the proposed number of jobs being created and square feet of the company's facility. Monument sign cost for the entrances of the park is also currently being researched.

Marketing materials have been designed and printed for promoting the Northwest Florida Industrial Park at I-10. Now that the pricing guidelines for the park have been set by the County Commission, TEAM is starting to promote the property with industries and related site consultants.

Plans are being finalized with Project Snake Eyes. The governor's office is currently helping us wrap up the deal which will bring 500 jobs to Santa Rosa County.
