TEAM Santa Rosa will be represented in Northwest Florida's Defense Coalition's 4th Annual Washington DC delegation. Our group will visit several members of Congress on Wednesday, May 12, as part of our fly-in. This defense support initiative provides us an opportunity to advocate for our military and their needs. This includes the F-35, Special Forces, oil drilling, infrastructure and other critical topics facing Northwest Florida.
