



Community supported agriculture program participation deadline

All those area residents wishing to participate in the Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program, courtesy of TEAM Santa Rosa through Panhandle Fresh Marketing Association, must register by May 1. For the first year, there are only 50 shares being offered. The CSA is for those who desire a weekly basket of locally grown in-season fresh fruit and vegetables. Deliveries will be made to various drop-off points each Saturday morning.

Shares for the program are \$30 per week and a minimum 13-week commitment of one season is required. Payment for the 13-week season must be made in full with registration.

Season 1: May 14- August 20 (13 weeks)

13 weeks = \$390

Season 2: August 21- November 26 (13 weeks)

13 weeks = \$390

Participants may choose to buy into the entire season by paying in full for the year (26 weeks). A five percent discount is being offered for those who purchase the entire year's worth of seasons. The price for a year's full season is \$741. Those interested are encouraged to participate with family and friends to offset the weekly cost.
